My dear Cooper,

I feel that in case they are not on the agenda already the following points should be put before the National Executive when it meets on the 12th instant:

1. Strategy to be adopted in regard to a censure motion on Government regarding Rabat and other issues and a general attitude to be adopted towards the Congress schism. I feel that specific instructions should be given to the Parliamentary Party in regard to the unfortunate statements made by C.C.Desai and Piloo Mody which have caused considerable concern among the ranks of the Party throughout the country.
2. Action to be taken in regard to the statements made by C.C.Desai and Piloo Mody.
3. Consideration of the question of cement decontrol and the situation arising out of the action taken by N.K.Somani, Piloo Mody and others in signing a letter to the Government in the company of communists and others and Mr. G.D.Somani's letter and Mr. Dandekar's remarks.
4. Consideration of the situation created in Gujarat by the statement made by C.C.Desai etc. in regard to joining hands with the Congress Leftists to overthrow the Gujarat Government.
- ✓ 5. Whether fresh instructions are necessary to U.P. M.L.As. in the light of recent efforts to topple the Government in U.P. with the support of the Prime Minister.
