U.N. world conscience

Silence inconceivable cf. Hungary

India's claim to judge issues by merit on test

Issue must be kept alive - heroic struggle continues

cf. Polish partition

Double standard cf. South Africa and Algeria

Two issues: (1) Human Rights - International Commission of
Jurists' Report - genocide of religious
group

Reports of refugees

(2) National Independence

Tibet not part of China

Reject ~~the~~ logic of imperialism
