On the other hand, new threat

Quote Tom Mboya :

"Africa must be vigilant. It does not wish
to exchange one form of colonialism from
another. It is aware that other and more
subtle forms of imperialism are always lying
in wait for that moment when it may relax
its vigilance, to come in and establish other
forms of oppression and exploitation."

Danger real - Prof. Potekhin, Head of the Soviet delegation to the All African Peoples' Conference, Accra, 1958: non-violence "is a harmful illusion purposefully disseminated by imperialists in order to prolong their rule in Africa... the theory of non-violence is a dangerous error." Tom Mboya criticized for compromise with the colonialists.

Chinese-Soviet penetration proceeds - *Arlio Abba*

Systematic propaganda - during twelve months ending November 1959, Soviet English-language broadcasts to Africa increased from 5.25 to 14 hours weekly, and programmes in Swahili started in January 1959.

Communist East Germany and Czechoslovakia also add African programmes.

According to Mao Tse-tung, who is cited by Diop, Communist Propagandist, local anti-imperialist forces must depend upon the aid of "international revolutionary forces."

Since 1955 "united front" tactics followed and Nkrumah who till then was attacked as a stooge of English imperialism became respectable.

Afro-Asian Peoples' Solidarity Conference, Cairo between December 1957 and January 1958 - H.D. Malaviya, Indian Secretary.

Pass Laws - Routine in U.S.S.R.!

Legitimate goals:

- (i) Multi-racial democracy, not majority
- (ii) Federation - e.g. Bourguiba - Maghreb Confederation
