Dear Sir,

You may have received a card about the meeting of the 18th inst. This meeting had to be called since many members made anxious enquiries about the future of the Swatantra Party in our State in view of the absence of the State level units of the other parties listed for merger. The meeting is called by the two joint Secretaries Messrs. A.S. Nagabhushana Rao and T. Ananta Rao, in consultation with Sri G.M. Gopal Krishna, the Joint Secretary who concurred with them ~~two other Joint Secretaries~~ that it is proper to call a meeting of this kind.

Since any member can become a delegate of the National Convention, it would have been appropriate if the consensuses of all members of all State Councils of the Party had been obtained since they are more responsible than the delegates. If such a method had been adopted, we would not have faced with the present confusion of 5 states units (Tamilnadu, Kerala, Maharashtra, Delhi and Haryana) declaring that they would continue to function as Swatantra Party. In the present changed situation that has developed subsequent to the national convention, it is clear that Mr. Piloo Mody's voice will not command as much respect and weight as he expected as has been pointed out in the editorial of the Indian Express dated 9.8.1974. The public impression is that the whole thing has been rushed through in a great hurry and that the whole question should be reconsidered in view of the step taken as many as five State units and in view of the sound views expressed by Mr. Masani.

In these circumstances I hope you will appreciate the convenience of the meeting scheduled for 18th inst. and make it convenient to preside over the same on account of the very important nature of the meeting. I am writing this at the request of the two joint Secretaries who have called the meeting. I hope you will communicate at your earliest convenience about your visit to Bangalore for presiding over the meeting. If you found it very inconvenient to attend the meeting you may authorise Mr. V.L. Narasimha Murthy to preside over the meeting.
