I thought you would not mind my dropping you a line in connection with a letter dated August 20 which has been addressed to Messrs. Sassoon J. David and Co. Ltd. by the General Secretary of the Swatantra Party (Maharashtra). I enclose an extra copy for easier reference on your part.

As it happens, I was responsible for getting these premises for the Swatantra Party in Bombay which was later expanded in the Maharashtra Unit through Mr. A.D. Shroff who was very helpful. This I did in my capacity as Chairman of the local Party. Later on when I resigned as Chairman of the local Party and became General Secretary of the National Organisation, I requested the Bombay Party to give a little bit of space in the office for the use of the National Party and this they were good enough to do.
