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My dear H.M.,

I thought you might care to see a Resolution I tabled for discussion at the National Convention of our Party in Delhi on August 4 and 5. This is by way of a compromise and way out between the two warring factions, led by Piloo Mody on the one side for his new hotchpotch party and a large number of Party members against a dissolution of the Party on the other side. I am hopeful that good sense will prevail on both sides and I really feel that what I have suggested will be not only a dignified way of facing what might otherwise be a split but also in tune with the needs of the country at the present time. I should like to think that you will respond positively to this approach.
