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Dear Mr. Shah,

Thank you for your letter of July 10. I have carefully thought of what you say but feel that at this stage it will be neither practical nor desirable for the National Convention of the Party to be cancelled. I hope you will be ^{come and} free ~~to~~ state your point of view.

In so far as I am concerned, the proper made for the conversion of the Party into a political ^{but} non-party organisation, is not based only on a desire to accommodate those who wish to form a new party but because I feel in the changed conditions none of the existing political parties including ours ^{has} very much of a future and that the time is appropriate for non-party educative work in view of the development of revolutionary conditions.
