I am writing this letter to inform you that I attended the meeting of the General Council of the Swatantra Party at Delhi and put up my view-point before the meeting. I feel that I did this quite forcefully. After I completed my speech, many senior members of the General Council appreciated what I had said. Among them were C.R. Narasimhan, Maharawal Laxman Singhji, H.M. Patel, and even D.N. Patodia. Even though you had not been able to come for the meeting, your letter addressed to Shri Piloo Mody had a very good effect on the meeting. As the copies of this letter were circulated to the members, your thoughts on the proposed dissolution of the Party were before them. I hope that the proposal of forming a front on the basis of a common programme for joint action may ultimately prevail; and that the Party

may not be dissolved in a haste.
