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Dear President,

My humble obeisance to your feet. Seven state parties joined together and are attempting to form a new party and our national party, Swatantra is making all its endeavours to form this party and it is a commendable step. Except our party, all other parties of the state are all divided ones on the State Level. They do not possess political character of high standard on the national level. Also they do not perform in good faith. They are all parties who joined with Nehru to crush our party without taking any interest in the national level. Those parties will not be averse of leaving parties as they have done previously when they left the Congress. On account of joining with the parties having no basic and strong ideals, in 1971-Election, our party incurred two national losses.

1. Congress syndicate and Jana Sangh parties acted themselves as superior to our party and to be cock of the walk and thus with that attitude they prevailed over us and our ideals. They attempted to assign the defeat to our party. In consequence thereof, our party incurred a dislike from public.
2. It became a very great loss to our party by making our great national leader and head Sri M.R. Masani keep aloof from politics. He is a great political scientist. But we have been deprived of his leadership and guidance.

I beg to state that I am not in a position to submit my suggestions in these matters. But I like to bring to your kind notice that we are not able to understand something prevailing from top rank to the ranks and file of the party.

The strength of our party is only on the fine and concrete ideals of our party and not on the strength of the members of the party. Foresight, Disciplined Leadership, efficient administration are the basic causes for the well maintenance of Democracy. Not by winning election. Nor by agitations.

My heart cries to hear that our Swatantra Party will be dissolved or will be amalgamated with other parties and at that the purity of our party has been thrown out. In these circumstances, I lost my peace and sound sleep and I am passing my days as a mechanic device.

My humble request is placed before you to do this:

I humbly request you to take all endeavours to make our great Leader Sri Masani to take part in politics and interest in our party help to become our party strong. Because such a sweet and lovely flower is being wasted in the sun without being made use of by any one.

I have placed my entire faith in your leadership and in your administration of our party. Please see that instead of amalgamating our parties with other parties, new concrete advises are being found to distribute to the members of the party to stand up with more vigour to stabilise the party and to become strong and stronger than ever before. We will dedicate all our efforts in promoting our party.
