My dear Rajaji,

I am enclosing the note of dissent sent by Mr. C. L. Narasimha Reddy on the Constitution amendment Bill dealing with the D.M.K. ^{with it}. I am told by Mr. Reddy that the D.M.K. People were happy. Some of our people are a little nervous about its possible reaction; on the whole it is quite reasonable.

One friend from Madanapalli told me today that there are rumours in Madras that the Government is thinking of taking ^{some action} against yourself and ourselves also, ~~some action~~.

Morarji Desai appealed while concluding his speech for support of all sections of the House for the Budget proposals once they come to be passed after discussion. It is quite possible that he is afraid of some agitation all over the Country against the New Taxes.

The two days' debate on the External Affairs was concluded by Jawaharlalji in a very ineffective Speech. The impression was that the Opposition scored on many points. As usual all the Congress ^{and C.P.I.} Speakers went on supporting their Non-alignment Policy. From our side we had two effective speeches from Gayathri Deviji and C. L. Narasimha Reddy; copies of which are being sent to you. Both our speakers had a good House.
