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My dear Kripalaniji,

Thank you for your letters of June 27 and July 4, forwarding your correspondence with Jai Prakash. I too am sorry that this discussion between you should have taken place in public.

However, as you say the idea of <sup>a</sup>minimum programme will have to be placed on the shelf for the moment.

I am afraid I am not coming up to Delhi till 12th August but will certainly look forward to seeing you then. There is just a possibility that Rajaji may come to Delhi for two or three days commencing August 13 or 14. In that event we can have discussions together. I am going to write to Jai Prakash if by any chance he will be in Delhi on or around that time. That way we might after all be able to salvage something. The effectiveness of these things, however, is always spoiled by needless publicity and I hope you will keep the possibility of Rajaji's visit to yourself/in order to avoid needless speculation in the press.
