My dear Masani,

This has reference to your memo dated the 13th June addressed to me as Treasurer of the Party.

I have already explained to you that, owing to the heavy calls on our friends in respect of the Bye-election at Rajkot, I do not regard this as an opportune moment for the begging bowl to be passed round again. Even so, I have had several discussions with Dharamsey and A.D.S. about the urgency of replenishing our Party chest. They are awaiting the statement which Dharamsey asked you to prepare on his return from Ooty. As soon as it is received, I propose to call a meeting to consider the situation and decide on ways and means of financing the normal functioning of the Party and building up a Reserve on which to operate at the time of the next Elections. I expect your Memorandum will set out clearly the objectives we have to keep in view.
