Rajajee is keen to have a public meeting in Madras during this month whenever it is convenient to us and I told him that I would go there any day after the 22nd which would be convenient to you.

✓ Shree Raghavendra Pratap Singh has written to me how it is imperative to reconstitute the U;P committee, and settle the responsibility on one or the other. Kindly suggest the way out.

? Shree Munshi is rightly keen that we should finalise the reorganisation of the General Council and convene its first meeting along with the C;O;C in August, as suggested by me so that we can place our viewpoint before the public in the name of our national leadership. So why not we convene the G;C with the new members as they are being suggested by the State Committees and accepted by us. In fact, the C;O;C can meet a day earlier and accept the state lists for General Council and enable the new members to attend the G;C meeting= we have to advise State Committees to invite the ~~new~~ new members, pending the C.O.C acceptance.
