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MR. M.R. MASANI'S SUPPLEMENTARY REPORT TO THE CENTRAL ORGANISING
COMMITTEE RE: BIHAR

In addition to the action recommended by Mr. Dahyabhai Patel and myself in our Report to the Central Organising Committee, I would like to make a further recommendation.

I was grateful to Mr. Dahyabhai Patel for readily responding, despite domestic reasons to the contrary, to my request to accompany me to Patna and to give me the benefit of his guidance and counsel.

During our stay in Patna, the request was repeatedly made that senior leaders of the Party like Prof. Ranga, myself and other members of the Central Organising Committee should visit Bihar in turn in order to put heart in, and to restore morale among, our members who feel they were deserted till recently by the Central Organisation and now by the local leader.

In the course of our discussion, more than one of our senior colleagues requested that Mr. Dahyabhai Patel should be asked to take personal interest in Bihar affairs and to visit that State regularly and I am sure that, if he were to agree to do so, this would be a great help to the Party and in particular to the Central Office in fulfilling this delicate and difficult assignment.

I would therefore recommend that the Central Organising Committee may ask Mr. Dahyabhai Patel to function as an additional link between the Centre and Bihar during the next few months. I would very much value Mr. Dahyabhai Patel's collaboration in this work and I am sure that we shall be able to work together in creating a sound and effective Unit of the Party in Bihar.
