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My dear Kooka,

Professor N.G. Ranga, M.P., left Delhi on an Air India ticket some days back to attend the International Parliament Union Conference in Copenhagen as one of the representatives of the Parliament of India. This Conference concluded a couple of days back and Professor Ranga is now in London.

Professor Ranga wishes to proceed to New York to attend a meeting of the International Peasants Union in Washington and wishes his ticket, which is a Delhi-London-Delhi ticket, to be changed into a Delhi-New York-Delhi ticket. We shall be glad to pay the difference in fares in rupees at this end to enable his ticket to be modified in this manner.

We shall be grateful if you will kindly tell us the amount of the cheque which we should pay in to your office here so that you may inform your London Office accordingly and ask them, in consultation with Professor Ranga, who can be contacted through the Office of the Indian High Commissioner in London, to change his ticket so that he may proceed to New York on the 3rd of September.
