My dear Masani

Thank you for your cable.
I have accordingly written to Air India
London asking them if they would fix up
a passage for me to Washington and quoted
the relevant sentence from your cable.

I have also sent you a cable-
it cost such a lot in this wretched place-
requesting you to make sure of reservation
of the return passage to & fro London & Washington.
I hope you will find it possible to make these
arrangements in time.

If your cable had not come yesterday
I would have reached Delhi by 5th night.
I made my fixtures almost pureca.
It will certainly be a good thing for our
party to be represented in an indirect
informal manner in USA at this juncture,
without any commitments. It is consistent
with our anti-Cp stand to support the
Green International.

I will be meeting the Liberal
International friend on Tuesday. Mr
Mallehier MP of the World Fed has been
here in this conference and we established
contacts.

I hope to start for Washington
on the 2nd or 3rd Sept, i.e. provided you
are able to fix up the passage.

I will reach London tomorrow
and contact the Air India and advise
them about my movements in England.
